

BIOFA Clear Rinsing Agent Article No. 4052

Properties

BIOFA Clear Rinsing Agent is a high-yielding concentrate for the gentle removal of stains like lime and water spots, etc. on glass, pots, dishes, stainless steel, etc. Also suited for manual and dishwasher cleaning. It is free of alkalines and phosphates, is biodegradable and has no chemical preservatives.

The employed cleaning raw materials and active ingredients have very good dirt and grease loosening properties and result in streak-free and glossy finishes.

Ingredients

Water, alcohol, non-ionic tenside 5-15%, citric acid.

Application

Dosage: 0.3 - 0.6 g/l (approx. 1/2 teaspoon). Water film drains away evenly when used in the correct concentration. Streaks can form when overdosed, droplets remain on dishes when underdosed. Dosing is automatic for dishwasher cleaning.

Note:

BIOFA Clear Rinsing Agent can also be used to clean the dishwasher. This is accomplished by adding 100-150 of BIOFA Clear Rinsing Agent to the detergent compartment, and then running the machine for a normal cleaning cycle. Lime and water spots on stainless steel and glass surfaces can be removed by dabbing a little BIOFA Clear Rinsing Agent onto the coarse side of a scotch scrubber and then scrubbing the surfaces. Then rinse with clear water and polish to a sheen with a dry rag.

Storage

Keep cool, away from frost, dry and properly sealed.

Container
